#### II. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- The Competition is held in accordance with the FEI Rules for Dressage Events, 26th edition, effective 1st January 2025, (https://inside.fei.org/fei/disc/dressage/rules) and FEI General Regulations, Pony Regulations and Veterinary Regulations currently in force.

## III. THE FEI CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE:

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriering and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

## VII. <u>ENTRIES:</u>

Definite Entries Extended to: <u>Sunday</u>, <u>30/11/2025 at 9:00 PM</u>
Late Entries: <u>LATE ENTRIES NOT PERMITTED</u>

- Entry fee per combination competing: 20KD/- \*\*
- \*\* This fee covers one rider per test
- The event is open to a **maximum of 40 starters** in total. In the event that this number is exceeded, all riders in the Senior I class are accepted first then the Preliminary Challenge entries are prioritized according to previous results
- A Rider/horse combination is only allowed to ride one test
- **Minimum age of horses:** 5 y.o. for both tests
- Minimum age of athletes: 12 y.o for Preliminary Test & 16 y.o. for Senior I Test
- A 5 y.o. horse is allowed to start only once
- Starting from 6 y.o. a horse is allowed to start twice under different riders
- If a horse is starting twice in the Preliminary test, the same horse cannot start in any other WCHA tests
- An athlete is allowed to start twice in Preliminary and Senior class but with two different horses
- Entries for all riders competing Per Club, must be sent in one excel sheet to: kefdressage@gmail.com
- Entries MUST be paid to Event Secretary on Sunday between 7-9 PM in Police Sports Federation
- No refunds

#### VIII. <u>IMPORTANT INFORMATION:</u>

- A vet check is compulsory on the morning of the competition. Horses passports must be provided during vet check. Vet Check Time will be announced later
- There will be an **arena familiarization** for horses on the morning of the show, if you wish to attend. Time will be announced later
- You are welcome to train your horse on Show Venue before the competition on Thursday and/or Friday evening
- **No reader** is allowed during the World Challenge
- All trot work is executed "sitting" unless otherwise indicated in the test
- Kindly read all rules and regulations related to the World Challenge Event related to marks, penalties, dress saddlery etc..
- A round table discussion with the judges after the event is required as part of the World Challenge agenda set by FEI.
- Videos from the Senior I classes will be viewed and analysed. Riders in the SENIOR
   I test are kindly asked to attend. It is also open to other riders if they wish to benefit

## IX. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

#### 1. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY:

The number of athletes required to present themselves for the prize-giving ceremony per level is 6

A minimum Score of 55% and above is required to be eligible for prize giving
